

Official proceedings of the City Council of the City of Marseilles of the meeting of October 16, 2024.

The City Council of the City of Marseilles met in the City Chamber of City Hall at the hour of 6:00 P.M. on October 16, 2024.

Pledge of Allegiance was said.

Roll call showed the following present: Mayor Hollenbeck, Commissioner Kaminski, Small, Scheib, and Buckingham. Absent: None.

Moved by Commissioner Kaminski seconded by Commissioner Buckingham that the minutes from the Council meeting of October 2, 2024 be approved as displayed and placed on file. Ayes: Commissioner Kaminski, Small, Scheib, Buckingham, and Mayor Hollenbeck. Nays: None.

Moved by Commissioner Kaminski seconded by Commissioner Buckingham that the accounts payable for the first half of October in the amount of \$76,948.68 be approved and a warrant be drawn on the City Treasury for the said amount. Ayes: Commissioner Kaminski, Small, Scheib, Buckingham, and Mayor Hollenbeck. Nays: None.

Moved by Commissioner Kaminski seconded by Commissioner Small that the payroll for the first half of October in the amount of \$61,256.54 be approved and a warrant be drawn on the City Treasury for said amount. Ayes: Commissioner Kaminski, Small, Scheib, Buckingham, and Mayor Hollenbeck. Nays: None.

Moved by Commissioner Kaminski seconded by Commissioner Small that the payment to Phalen Steel in the amount of \$136,869.00 for the city hall and police department remodel project be approved. Ayes: Commissioner Kaminski, Small, Scheib, Buckingham, and Mayor Hollenbeck. Nays: None.

Moved by Commissioner Schieb seconded by Commissioner Buckingham that the payment to IDOT in the amount of \$41,481.14 for 11 Street project be approved. Ayes: Commissioner Kaminski, Small, Scheib, Buckingham, and Mayor Hollenbeck. Nays: None.

Moved by Commissioner Schieb seconded by Commissioner Small that pay estimate #2 to Universal Asphalt in the amount of \$65,510.86 for Ryall and 2<sup>nd</sup> Street be approved. Ayes: Commissioner Kaminski, Small, Scheib, Buckingham, and Mayor Hollenbeck. Nays: None.

Commissioner Scheib asked for the council's blessing to move forward with planning a veteran owned food truck event. The council agreed to move forward with planning the event.

Mayor Hollenbeck stated there is not a Seattle Sutton contract to place on file. The deadline for purchase has passed. The building was appraised for \$170,000, Seattle purchased for \$42,000 and has put \$150,000 into updates. Seattle would sell the building to the City for \$42,000 this would be the City's responsibility to maintain as public property.
